Several of our satellite offices have sleep labs located in them for the convenience of patients. Therapist consultations are available onsite to assist and instruct patients with the use of continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) therapy for obstructive sleep apnea.

Registered respiratory therapists work hand-in-hand with the physicians and the patients to ensure optimal sleep therapy modalities. Clinical research is the study of an investigational drug or treatment method to evaluate its ability to prevent, diagnose or treat a disorder or disease.

Advanced MRI Services

MRI is a safe, painless diagnostic imaging procedure that enables a physician to view computer-generated images of the body. NNA's MRI facilities specialize in brain, head, neck and spinal cord imaging, utilizing the latest technological advances in software and equipment. Total body, extremity and specialty imaging also are available.



Experienced, registered MRI technologists perform the exams, and board-certified neurologists or neuro-radiologists interpret results.

Neurodiagnostic Testing

NNA utilizes the latest equipment and technology for neurodiagnostic testing—the study of nerve and muscle diseases. Fellowship-trained physicians and certified technicians perform the following:

- EMG (electromyogram) helps diagnose diseases such as carpal tunnel, ALS or myasthenia gravis that damage muscles, nerves and neuromuscular junctions;
- Nerve conduction studies reveal how electrical signals travel to a nerve and are used to diagnose nerve disorders;
- EEG (electroencephalogram) records brain electrical activity (brain waves) to help diagnose seizure disorders and evaluate sleep disorders, head injuries, tumors and other disorders;
- Evoked potentials check nerve pathways and help diagnose or assess neurological functions and abnormalities.
